Entry Fees: Entry \$50. Enter and pay on the day. Clubman class just \$30 plus race licence. M.N.Z. licence required. Day licences can be purchased at sign on for \$20. Light meal at prize giving approx. \$15, pay at sign on.

Sign On: 8:15 – 9:15am. Rider’s Briefing 9:45am. Race starts 10:00am. No look lap.

Race Format: MNZ cross country rules apply except for the following **Supplementary Rules:** Failure to ride the correct course = 1hr penalty. Start format 3 riders per 30 seconds with time corrected. Riders may have to stop at check points along the course. There may be bottlenecks and riders may have to dismount. **No tear offs.**

Prizes: Trophies to 3rd for each class, except clubman. Annual engraved cup for 1st overall. All riders attending prize giving will be in the draw to win a XRC steering damper. All finishers receive a finisher’s nut made by Roberts Engineering. Use of Dakins portable toilets on site, with free toilet paper (for the pre-race nerves).

Prize Giving: Pegasus Arms Restaurant and Bar, Oxford Terrace, Christchurch. Drinks from 5pm, prize giving around 6pm followed by a light meal. Pay for your meal at sign on.
