

## **S.I. Trial Championship Kaikoura, Level 2 Covid Plan.**

**Before arriving at this event, ensure you have read and understood this safety plan and your role in it.**

Due to the nature of a Trials event social distancing between competitors is easily maintained however there are times when close contact between competitors and officials is required. This plan has been adopted to reduce the risk of community transmission of COVID-19 at this event.

### **Do Not attend this event if:**

You have been diagnosed with the COVID19 (Coronavirus) or been in contact with anyone with COVID-19

You have arrived from overseas in the last 14 days

You are unwell and could potentially have COVID19 (difficulty breathing, coughing, cold-like symptoms)

### **General hygiene**

Regularly thoroughly wash and dry your hands with soap and paper towels or use sanitiser for 20 seconds. Do not touch your face. Sneeze or cough into your elbow or tissue. Dispose of tissues in a rubbish container.

### **Physical distancing**

Keep a 1m distance from other people involved with the event and contact tracing can be carried out. i.e. other competitors, officials etc.

Keep a 2m distance from other people not involved with the event and contact tracing cannot be carried out. i.e. spectators, farm workers, property owners etc.

### **Emergency management - probable or confirmed COVID-19 case**

If you suspect someone at the event is showing signs of COVID-19 isolate them from others and contact Healthline. Inform the organiser and carry out any advice given to them from health officials.

Contact tracing information will help identify those who have had close contact with the infected person 24 hours before they showed symptoms. Keep a record of all contacts and have this information available if required.

### **Sign On**

Please maintain social distancing and use hand sanitiser when queueing to sign on.

Officials will wear face shields and gloves.

Have your licence filled out and drop it in the box provided.

Officials will clean and then check licences.

### **Walking sections and Queueing**

Maintain social distancing at all times.

### **Scoring**

Observers and scorers will wear face shields and gloves.

Riders will hand their card to the observer for clicking but maintain arm's length distancing and move on immediately to reduce time spent together.

At the end of each round rider will drop their card in the box provided and collect a new one from the scorer. Again, maintain arm's length distancing and move on immediately to reduce time spent together.

### **End of event**

Score board will be updated. View scores and move on quickly. Maintain social distancing.
